Mini Animal Candle Making

A. GENERAL REMARKS

- 1. Intended for children ages 8 and up with adult supervision.
- 2. Candles must be lit by adults.

3. Keep young children and pets away from lit candles and do not leave them unattended.

4. Cover the working area with scrap paper as the wax sheets may stain the table.


5. A hairdryer is required.

B. CONTENTS

1 Mould, 8 coloured wax sheets, 1 craft tool, candle wick, 6 gift cards and detailed instructions.

C. MOULD

There are two types of mould – the main body and the accessories. All animal designs are made from the same main body. By adding different accessories to the main body, you can create different animals. You are recommended to start by moulding the main body.



D. INSTRUCTIONS


1. SOFTENING THE WAX -

Choose a design from Section E and select a colour for the main body. Soften the wax sheet with a 5-second blast from a hairdryer. Blow from a distance on low heat.

Caution: If the wax sheet is overheated and starts to melt, do not try to handle the hot melted wax, let it cool down and harden again.


2. MOULDING -

Take a small lump of softened wax sheet. Knead it and divide it into small balls with a diameter of about 15mm. Press the balls one by one into the mould. Soften them with a hairdryer again if the wax becomes hardened. Cut the candle wick into 6 equal lengths for later use. When the mould is half-filled, place the candle wick onto the mould, and make sure part of the candle wick protrudes from the cavity. Continue to fill up the rest of the mould. Press a few more times to ensure that no gaps are left. Remove any excess wax with the craft tool. Flatten the wax by further pressing evenly on the surface.



3. LEAVE THE WAX TO SET -


It will take around 10 minutes for the wax to harden. Remove the wax from the mould by gently pressing the mould from behind to release it. The main body is done! If the result is unsatisfying, you can redo it by softening the wax with a hairdryer and repeating steps 2-3.



4. COMPLETING THE BODY WITH ACCESSORIES -

Repeat steps 1 to 3 to make the accessories, only this time you don't need to insert the candle wick, and it will only take less than 1 minute for the accessories to set. After moulding all the required accessories, soften them a bit with the hairdryer and stick them onto the main body you moulded earlier.

To make a nose and eyes for the animal candle, take small lumps of the wax, knead them into small balls with a diameter of about 2mm, and then stick them onto the main body. Repeat these steps to make more candles with different designs.



TIPS

• Multicolour candles:

You can mould the main body and accessories with multicolour by adding different coloured wax to the same cavity. Use this technique to make the rabbit, panda, monkey, fox and more. You are recommended not to use more than 3 colours in the same cavity, otherwise the candle will look muddy.

• Kneading Your Own Shapes:

For making the elephant's tusks and trunk, and the fox's tail. Some mould shapes are not included, but you can make them yourself.

Making a Personalized Candle:

To make a birthday candle, use an oil based marker to write a number on the mini plaque.
