
E. PRINT PATTERN & COLOUR MIXING GUIDE



- 1. Solid Colour Print: apply a single colour of paint on the stencil, gently slide the scraper from the top to the bottom.
- 2. Gradient Colour Print: apply 2-3 colours of paint to the stencil, mixing the paints slightly to create a gradient. Then slide the scraper down from the top.
- 3. Marble Colour Print: place a few colours on the palette, use a toothpick to move backwards and forwards to create a herringbone pattern. Pick an area of colour and transfer it with the scraper, then slide the paint down from top to bottom.
- 4. Colour Splashes: mix paint and water in a ratio of 1:1, put it in a sprayer and spray onto the surface.

Colour mixing guide:

- Purple = Pink + Blue
- Orange = Yellow + Pink
- Lime = Yellow + a little Blue
- Green = Blue + a little Yellow
- Brown = Yellow + Pink + a little Blue

A. SAFETY MESSAGES


- 1. Please read through all the instructions and keep them since it contains important information.

B. REMARKS


- 1. Always work on a solid, level working surface and try to keep the area neat and clean.
- 2. If clothes are stained by paint then wash them immediately. Dried paint may leave mild stains on clothing even when they are washed. Put on your apron or wear old working clothes as necessary.

C. CONTENTS

Part A: 1 backpack (27.5x36cm), Part B: 1 printing rack, Part C: 6 adhesive stencils, Part D: EVA scraper set (1 large, 1 small), Part E: 3 bottles of fabric paint.



D. INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Place the backpack on a level working surface and smooth to remove all wrinkles. Place a piece of paper inside the backpack to prevent paint seeping through during printing. Choose your stencil pattern, peel the plastic film off the back, position and stick the stencil on the backpack. You can also mask off the 4 sides of the stencil with adhesive tape (from home) as shown to further prevent the paint from bleeding outside of the stencil.
- 2. Squeeze a dollop of paint at the top of the stencil, making sure the volume of paint is sufficient to cover the whole pattern. Choose an appropriate size EVA scraper. Gently slide the paint from top to bottom. Repeat until the stencil graphic is fully covered with paint. (Use your own colour scheme or refer to the illustration as shown on the box for ideas. You can refer to the PRINT PATTERN & COLOUR MIXING GUIDE in Section E for more ideas.)
- 3. Using a tissue (from home), carefully remove the paint that remains on the stencil. After it is cleaned, gently peel the stencil off the backpack. Do it with special care as the wet paint on the stencil may stain the backpack. (Tip: if you stain your backpack, you can use the same colour to print a pattern to cover the stain.)
- 4. Leave the printed backpack to dry for approximately 1-2 hours. To speed up the process, you can use a hairdryer or fan. Your beautiful backpack is finished.
- 5. The stencils and EVA scrapers can be reused for future projects. Clean them with a wet tissue (from home), dry and store them with the printing rack provided.
- 6. You can apply the same techniques and use stencils to print on other items of fabric e.g. a T-shirt, or greeting cards. You can also experiment with different paints and materials to create your own design. For example, you can print gift cards with watercolours or apply acrylic paint on a phone case. It is a good daily craft activity.
